

Jack's Waterfront Bar – Band Requirements

Set up

Set up may vary depending on the date and events scheduled at bar
In general the following will apply

For evening bands playing at 9:30,
All Bands must be set up by 8.
Sound Check 1 hour before start time

For afternoon bands playing from 3-7,
All Bands must be set up and sound check 30 minutes prior to start time

PAYMENTS

Jack's requires a W-9 to be filled out prior to playing
Payment will be made by check, please note who to make check payable to, if not
band name
All bands will receive a 1099 at the end of the year for tax purposes.

Bar Tabs

Bands will no longer be allowed to have a bar tab, bands will only be given beers,
water and n/a beverages
A cooler will be provided on stage with the following:

Bands 2 people and less
No more than 12 beers
6 waters
any other non-alcoholic beverage of your choice.

Bands of 3-5 members
No more than 18 beers
8 waters
any other non alcoholic beverage of your choice

Bands of 6-8
No more than 22 beers
12 waters
Any other non-alcoholic beverage of your choice

**If you are interested in a Liquor Drink, a tab can be started with a credit and paid
in full by band member at the end of the evening.

**Jack's Bartenders will not be authorized to change anything above. Any special
requests will need to be made to Keri McCann or Janeen Russell prior to playing.

We expect a certain level of professionalism and ask that you do not get intoxicated.
If we find that you are, we reserve the right to ask you to stop playing and will pay
based on the number of hours played, and it may result in cancellation of future
dates.
